We have waited 3 years for this opportunity to extend Blair Avenue west. Councilman Haynes inquired what the financial obligation is for the City, to which Mayor Brinlee stated the contract calls for "no less than 20%". He stated this federal funding is going away so this is the last chance to take advantage of it. Councilman Sims asked what options we have if, when the precise amount is known and it's more than City can pay. Mayor Brinlee answered that if there is any reason we are not happy with the contract, we can turn it down.

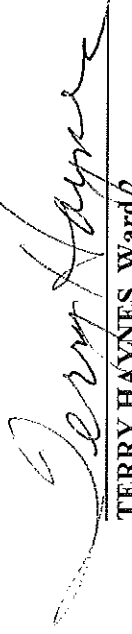
